

**PLENARY LECTURE “MEDIEVAL HISTORY”**

Title: **“Anti-Judaism”, “Jew-Hatred” and “Anti-Semitism”**

This panel will examine the phenomenon and discuss the essence of the terms “Jew-Hatred” and “Anti-Judaism” in the Middle Ages, with emphasis on theological, social, economic and mental aspects. Its goal is to refresh the discourse in the field by inviting speakers who will present new or updated research rather than material that has been presented at previous events. The aim is to promote investigation of the concept of Jew-hatred in the Middle Ages – and the medieval roots of modern Anti-Semitism – through a number of different perspectives: a critical examination of sources; varied viewpoints of history, literature and art history; and the lens of religious research.
